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## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### When do Baptisms take place?

Baptisms take place in the Church on the first and third Sunday of each month at 11.45am. Please arrive at the Church by 11.35am.

### Who should our Godparents be?

One Godparent, either male or female, is sufficient for this Sacrament. Usually parents choose two Godparents. At least ONE of your Godparents should be a confirmed Catholic of at least 16 years of age.

#### What about a donation?

On the occasion of a child's Baptism it is customary to give a donation to the Church. This Donation goes to the *Clergy Pastoral Revenue Fund* to help pay for the care of the clergy in the Diocese.
