## "YOU MUST LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOUR AS YOURSELF."

The Church celebrates the Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time this weekend and our readings present us with the challenge of living out the command: "You must love your neighbour as yourself."

Our Gospel begins by outlining the steps we are challenged to take when a brother of ours has done something wrong. Out of love, out of a desire to ensure that they live a good life, we are to 'have it out with him alone'. Then if they do not listen, then we take two or three witnesses and if that fails, then we take the matter to the community. Only after all three steps have failed to produce a correction, can we reject our brother, treating him like a pagan or a tax collector.

Love asks us to go to extraordinary lengths so that no one is automatically rejected. The Church truly has the power to bind and loose and what is bound or loosed on earth, will be bound and loosed in heaven. This authority, this gift, is not and exercise in power but of love.

So often in our world, the Church is seen as saying 'no' to things, but you and I are invited to recognise that we are not simply saying 'no' but a much bigger 'yes'. Yes to allowing ourselves and others to be respected and to live full and meaningful lives without being treated as objects to be used up and rejected.

That is the importance of the great promise Jesus makes at the end of our Gospel this weekend: "if two of you on earth agree to ask anything at all, it will be granted to you by my Father in heaven." What we are agreeing too is for the good of all, it is not some sort of deal, where two people get to ask for whatever they want. We are being invited to recognise not just what a person may desire or want, but what they need. Jesus then continues and promises "where two or three meet in my name, I shall be there with them." We are being invited to recognise Jesus in our midst, not just what I think may make me happy.

Loving ourselves may not be easy, but without recognising our own talents and gifts how can we possibly know others? Let us pray that we may strive to love others as we are challenged to.

## REFLECTION
