

As the Father sent me, so am I sending you

Today we celebrate the Second Sunday of Easter which is also Divine Mercy Sunday. In the Gospel of John, we hear the story of Jesus appearing to his disciples in the closed room. The disciples lived with fear, locking themselves in the room.

Fear is an unpleasant emotion caused by awareness of danger. When fear enters our life, we close in on ourselves and resist opening ourselves to others and the world. Fear does not allow us to be free. Jesus was aware of the fear of the disciples, so he must break that fear by appearing to them and breathed the Holy Spirit on them.

Let us call in to mind that Jesus came back and stood amongst the very people who followed him. Also, they were the very people who denied and abandoned Jesus during his arrest. When Jesus appeared to them, he showed them his wounds. This signifies that through the wounds of Jesus we are being forgiven. Through the wounds of Jesus, the world is transformed through God's Divine Mercy.

Jesus then gifted the Holy Spirit to the disciples and sent them for mission. The mission entrusted to the disciples is to go the ends of the world to proclaim the joy of the resurrection of Jesus and to preach about the Mercy of God. Jesus encouraged them to go out and preach about the forgiveness of God. It is through the Divine Mercy of God that Jesus must die and rise from the dead to draw people to God.

The message for us as Christians of today is to experience the Mercy of God in our lives and be able to share God's mercy with others. We are invited to forgive each other and to love one another. It is through forgiveness that relationships are restored, and peace is experienced.
