## Through Jesus we receive new life

On this Thirteenth Sunday In Ordinary Time, we hear from Mark's Gospel the miracle of Jesus raising a young girl from death and the healing of the woman with a hemorrhage. The two key points the Gospel stresses are desperation and compassion.

There are two scenes St Mark records; one is the synagogue official named Jairus begged Jesus to cure his daughter. Second, is the woman with a hemorrhage who desired to touch Jesus's cloak and was healed. These two scenes highlight the type of attitude we humans must acquire. To be desperate means we are aware of our human needs and desire to seek assistance from Jesus. When we have our needs, we must always reach out to Jesus.

Jesus is always ready to attend to our needs. Through his compassionate heart he is open to our needs. The heart of Jesus is the heart that cares for our needs. He understands our needs and is always willing to help us. Jesus is the face of the Father. He carries out the will of the Father by giving life to humanity and transforming life. In life we face many challenges both physical and spiritual. However, Jesus is the one sent by the Father to heal and save us.

Our invitation as Christians is to recognize our needs and to be able to reach out to Jesus. What are the things we want Jesus to heal in our lives. Let us be desperate to reach out to him. The healing power of Jesus transforms and strengthens our lives. Our challenge is to experience the healing power of Jesus in our lives first then we be able to go out and be Christ like to those who need healing in their lives. Whether through their physical needs or spiritual needs. Jesus is sending us to go and bring healing to others.
