## God is with us

The readings of the Fifth Sunday of Easter invite us to reflect on the importance of Faith and how it is founded upon God's love. The gift of Faith helps us to see God in every situation we find ourselves in.

In the Acts of the Apostles, we hear the story of Paul and Barnabas visiting communities encouraging people to persevere in faith. They make people see the reality of what faith can do to our lives. Despite the hardships we face in life, faith is the source of light that helps us find God in those moments.

In the book of Apocalypse, Jonn reminds us that God is with us. He will wipe away our tears and take away sadness in our lives. Through His Son He has renewed our lives. John wants us to recognize the renewal God has done to our lives through His Son Jesus.

In the Gospel we are reminded repeatedly of the commandment of love. Jesus encourages us to love others like God has loved us. Jesus has revealed the love of God to us. Love must be lived out. To love others means to respond to the needs of others by taking actions to serve.

The message this Sunday is to ask ourselves how we express our faith when we are faced with hardships and does our faith helps us to realize God in challenging situations? St John gives us a comforting message reminding us that God is with us always and is always ready to renew our lives. We must have trust in him and believe in him.

Dear Sisters and Brothers of the Diocese of Parramatta,

I am writing to you all to let you know that I have convened a conference to be held for all our clergy (both priests and deacons) on the Central Coast commencing on the evening of Tuesday 20 May 2025 and concluding on Friday 23 May 2025 in the morning.

The last time that the clergy of the Diocese held a residential conference was in May 2016 before I was installed as the 4<sup>th</sup> Bishop of Parramatta. Thus, it has almost been ten years since the clergy have had an opportunity to be together for any meaningful time.

Much has happened since I came to the Diocese, not least being our Diocesan Synod and our new Pastoral Plan that emerged from the Synod. The clergy of the Diocese need time to be together to assist the building up of their fraternal relationships, and for some much-needed input on topics that are very relevant to parish clergy ministering in the context of our current world.

That means that for three days the normal liturgical schedules in our parishes will be disrupted. However, with the assistance of some retired priests and some priests from religious congregations Mass will be available at six major churches in the Diocese for those who wish to attend daily Mass from Wed 21 May – 23 May 2025.
