Habemus Bonum Pastorem!

The world—not only Catholics—was filled with excitement and surprise in recent days. A momentous event unfolded last week as the cardinal electors entered the conclave to choose a new leader. It was the Church's profound expression of loving trust in Christ's promise that He will always be with us, guiding His Church. From the conclave, a new leader emerged—not only chosen by the cardinals but also by the heart of the Good Shepherd Himself, who promised to continue leading His flock.

The joyful proclamation Habemus Papam! reminds us of God's faithfulness to His word: "I will give you shepherds after my own heart..." (Jeremiah 3:15). Christ continues to lead His Church through the shepherds of our time. On the Fourth Sunday of Easter, the Church celebrates Christ, the Good Shepherd.

Christ assures us that He knows His sheep—they hear His voice and follow Him. He promises to give them eternal life, and they shall never perish (cf. John 10:27–30). He is the Shepherd who laid down His life for His flock and leads them to the spring of life-giving water, where God will wipe away every tear (cf. Revelation 7:9, 14b–17).

Faith allows us to see that hostility and suffering in the world are not signs of God's absence. Jealousy, violence, persecution, and insecurity have long been part of the human experience. Yet, in this perilous valley, the Church walks courageously in hope, trusting Christ to shepherd His people through all trials.

We now have Pope Leo XIV, who invites us to journey as a synodal Church—a missionary Church committed to compassion and closeness, especially to those who suffer. His leadership reflects a deep commitment to inclusivity and social justice.

With a new shepherd, the Church continues her mission amid a complex world. She remains firm—not by her own strength, but because the Lord calls her to be a light to the nations and an instrument of salvation (cf. Acts 13:47). Following the Good Shepherd may involve trials, but we walk in confidence, knowing He cares for us and holds us securely in His hands. We are never alone.

May you clearly hear the voice of the Good Shepherd—and follow Him.
