## All he tells you will be taken from what is mine

We celebrate this weekend Trinity Sunday, the solemnity, when we contemplate the very nature of God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Christians, like our Jewish and Muslim sisters and brothers believe in one God, not multiple gods. However, with the revelation of Jesus, Christians have come to understand that one God as a trinity, three persons.

It is passages, like the one we hear from John's Gospel today, that helps us 'understand' the Trinitarian nature of God. I say 'understand' because this is a profound mystery and you and I will not be able to fully grasp the reality of God until the end of time.

For me, one of the beautiful elements of our understanding of God as Trinity is that God's very nature is communal. When we form the Church, the body of Christ then our community reflects and is being drawn into the very nature of God. This is why the work of ecumenism is so important so that divisions among Christians can be overcome.

Jesus is able to say that the Holy Spirit will lead us to the complete truth but that what he speaks is what he has learnt, for what he speaks will be taken from Jesus. Jesus is aware of how he speaks, not from himself but what the Father wants; the Holy Spirit will complete our knowledge but again, will not teach something 'new' but only what he has learnt. The Father speaks a word, that Word becomes the Son. The Father and the Son love one another and that love is the Holy Spirit.

Creation is an outpouring of the communal nature of God and you and I are being called upon to cooperate in God's work. How do we build up community, how do we work at overcoming divisions, how are we builders of peace, in our own lives, in the lives of our family and friends, our community and countries and all of creation? There can be many divisions and reasons for isolation in our lives and our world but can we look beyond those surface elements and go deeper to what unites us?

May God bless you, all those you love and all who love you.

## **LITURGICAL MINISTRY COURSE** SEPTEMBER 2025



The Liturgical Ministry Formation Courses will recommence in September 2025 in Blacktown. This free formation is open to anyone in the diocese interested in serving within the Liturgical Ministries either as Readers, Extraordinary Ministers of Communion, Ministers of Communion to the Sick and Dying and Ministers at the Altar. To enrol and for more information, please contact the Parish Office. Registrations close 19 August, 2025 but spaces are limited so enrol now to avoid disappointment.

Course participants along with existing liturgical ministers are reminded that as part of the Diocese of Parramatta's commitment to ensuring all children and adults at risk are safe, respected, protected and supported in our care, all volunteers (including Liturgical Ministers) in our parishes are required to complete mandatory safeguarding training. Additionally, all Ministers at the Altar and Acolytes should have a current Working with Children check that has been verified by the Diocese of Parramatta.
