Ordinary Time

There was a significant weather disruption in our NSW region last week. An advisory was issued to remain cautious, stay informed through official channels, and report any storm damage. Even after the immediate threat had passed, continued vigilance was encouraged as the region began to recover from the recent severe weather event.

Though the tempest has passed, the traces of the squalls compel the neighborhood to act — to repair destroyed gutters, clean up fallen leaves and trees, and restore things displaced by the storm. Once all of that is done, we return to our ordinary routine — to ordinary time. But ordinary does not necessarily mean downtime or boring time. It calls us to live out the reality of our lives with purpose.

This 14th Sunday of Ordinary Time invites us to reflect on what unfolds in the ordinary seasons of our faith life:

The Church rejoices in the fruits of redemption — the gift of the Holy Spirit. This grace-filled image is beautifully portrayed in the prophecy of Isaiah (66:10–14): a people once in exile now restored, embraced by Jerusalem like children comforted at their mother's breast. It is a vision of tenderness, reconciliation, and divine consolation.

St. Paul, writing to the Galatians (6:14–18), reminds us that salvation does not come from observing the old law but from becoming a new creation in Christ. What matters now is not external observance but interior transformation — a life conformed to the crucified Lord. Paul bears on his body the marks of Jesus, signs not of defeat but of belonging and mission.

In the Gospel of St. Luke (10:1–12, 17–20), Jesus sends out the seventy-two with urgency: "The kingdom of God has come near to you." They are not sent in comfort, but in detachment and reliance on divine providence. Their mission is to bring peace and healing and to proclaim the nearness of God. It is the Lord who sends the missionary and shares with them the salvation Christ gained through His cross.

At the heart of it all lies a humbling truth: a missionary is a justified sinner.



LITURGICAL MINISTRY COURSE SEPTEMBER 2025

Additionally, all Ministers at the Altar and Acolytes should have a current Working with Children check that has been verified by the Diocese of Parramatta.













