Following Christ must be a well-calculated risk.

Following Christ is not an impulsive emotional decision—it is a conscious, deliberate act that demands the whole of one's life. It is a path that requires calculation, discernment, and surrender. The Scriptures invite us to reflect deeply on what it truly means to be a disciple.

The Book of Wisdom (9:13-18b) reminds us that we cannot know the will of God on our own. "Who can learn the counsel of God, or who can discern what the Lord wills?" The answer is clear: only through wisdom and the Spirit of God. These are not abstract concepts—they are God's own guidance within us, helping us weigh the true cost of discipleship and empowering us to make courageous decisions in faith.

St. Paul's letter to Philemon (9-10, 12-17) gives us a real-world example. Onesimus, once a slave, has become a Christian under Paul's influence. Paul does not simply return a runaway servant; he sends him back as a brother in Christ. This profound transformation reflects the new life that comes with following Jesus—a life that transcends social divisions. Paul applies the principle that "in Christ, there is neither slave nor free" and challenges others to do the same. True discipleship leads not just to personal holiness but to social change, justice, and fraternity.

But discipleship is not cheap, Luke's gospel tells us (Luke 14: 25-33). It calls for total surrender—even to the point of martyrdom. The martyrs of the Church are honored not for their suffering, but for their unwavering commitment to Christ. They gave everything. Their sacrifice is the clearest example of what it means to calculate the cost and still say "yes."

To follow Jesus is to renounce all that holds us back—and in doing so, to gain the fullness of life that only God can give.
