Joseph ... Do Not Be Afraid

As we come to the Fourth Sunday of Advent, we draw closer to the end of our Advent journey this year, one of the themes that we can reflect upon is the idea of change. Our loving God often asks us to change our minds or outlook or behaviour to store up treasure for ourselves in Heaven or to have our names written in the book of life.

In the Gospel we hear Matthew's version of the birth of Jesus, focusing on Joseph. We are told Joseph had made up his mind to divorce Mary, after she was found to be pregnant but, in a dream, the angel of the Lord came to him and convinced him to change his mind. The Angel asks Joseph to not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife. The pregnancy was not the result of infidelity but the power of the Holy Spirit. Joseph did what the angel of the Lord had said. This is critical because it is through Joseph that Jesus is descended from David.

Can we be inspired by the example of Joseph and change our minds? Do we have the courage to change or are we too afraid to see things from a different perspective? We are preparing for the joy of the birth of Jesus at Christmas and of course the birth of a child transforms lives and 'change' is hardly an adequate description of the difference a baby makes to the household and family.

Our perspective and outlook can be transformed because the birth of a child invites us to recognise that we are no longer living our lives for ourselves but for another. Parents have talked to me about being tired, tired like never before, being stressed and being time poor but they also reflect about how the new member of the family brings joy and hope like nothing else.

Are we open to change? Can we allow ourselves to know that God is offering us something so precious? All to easily we can get caught up in the silly season, but I hope and pray that each of us can take some time to recognise the difference the birth of Jesus makes in our lives and our world.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The tragedy at Bondi Beach yesterday has shocked and deeply saddened our entire community, with many carrying fear, grief and unanswered questions.

Such violence is a grave assault on human dignity and can never be justified. We condemn this act unequivocally and reject all hatred that seeks to harm innocent people. There is no place for antisemitism, especially in Australia.

Together with all people, and with the wisdom of the Holy Spirit, we stand in solidarity with the Jewish community and pray for all those affected – those who have lost their lives or been injured, and the many individuals, families and communities whose lives have been changed in an instant.

We also pray for the first responders, healthcare workers, and members of the public who acted with courage and compassion in the face of danger – protecting others, offering help and bringing calm and support amid uncertainty. These acts of self-giving love and care reflect the very best of our humanity, our shared values, and our hope for each other.

Let us continue to offer our care, compassion and prayers, calling on Mary, our Mother and Queen of Peace, to intercede for us.

At times like this, it is vital that we do not allow fear or anger to divide us. Violence, retaliation and discrimination are never the answer, even in the face of terrorism and antisemitism.

As Pope Leo XIV reminds us, peace is "an unarmed peace and a disarming peace, humble and persevering. It comes from God, God who loves us all unconditionally." This is the peace to which we are called, even when the path is difficult.

I invite our Diocesan community to pray for healing, for comfort for all who mourn, and for a renewed commitment to unity, mutual respect and peace across our diverse faiths and cultures. May we continue to stand together against violence in all its forms. May God be close to all who are suffering, and may His peace rest upon our community.


