Advent's Promise: Preparing Hearts for Christ's Coming

One quiet evening this week, I watched the moon rise in the sky. I wondered if it was growing toward fullness—not as a scientific question, but as a gentle murmur amid the quiet stirrings of wonder and calm. It spoke of a promise shining beyond the darkness. Advent invites us, too, to lift our eyes from life's busyness and prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ.

The Second Sunday of Advent gently calls us to turn toward the promised future—a future where Christ will come in glory. Advent reminds us that Jesus' coming is not only the quiet, humble birth in Bethlehem, but also His promised return, bringing salvation, fulfillment, and peace to the world. The Scripture readings call us to hope, to prepare, and to live with expectation, ready to welcome Him.

Isaiah offers us a vision of a transformed world: the wolf will dwell with the lamb, the leopard with the young goat, and the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the Lord (Isaiah 11:1-10). This is more than a poetic image; it is a promise that God's peace will renew all creation. True hope, Isaiah reminds us, moves us out of passivity. It calls us to imagine a better world and to live in ways that reflect God's justice and mercy.

St. Paul, writing to the Christians in Rome, prays that the God of endurance and encouragement grant them this same knowledge of the Lord. He urges them to live in harmony, think in accordance with Christ, and glorify God with one voice (Romans 15:4-9). Paul echoes Isaiah: peace begins in the heart, in our families, and in our communities.

Advent invites us to leave our comfort zones and enter the wilderness of preparation. Like John the Baptist, we are called to repentance and renewal (Matthew 3:1-12), so that Christ may find room in us. Let us hold fast to hope, trusting God's promise, so that one day the earth will indeed be filled with the knowledge of the Lord—and peace will reign.

Our parish here at St. Andrew-Marayong, will celebrate Misa de Gallo at 4:30 am each morning from 16 to 24 December 2025.

Mesa de Gallo, which literally means "Rooster's Mass," is a centuries-old dawn tradition in which the faithful rise before sunrise to keep vigil in hopeful anticipation of Christ's coming. Celebrated as a nine-day Masses at dawn or early morning, it expresses Advent watchfulness, Marian devotion, preparation for the celebration of the mystery of Incarnation, Eucharistic commitment, and communal solidarity as the Church joyfully prepares for Christmas.
