TRUE DISCIPLESHIP MEANS LIVING ACCORDING TO GOD’S WILL

Friends,

We gather this Sunday, the Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time. The readings invite us to reflect on the nature of discipleship. God calls us with a purpose, and we are called to align our lives with God’s will.

In the first reading, Jeremiah struggles with his mission, feeling that it has become overwhelming. Yet, he understands that he cannot suppress God’s Word. His suffering leads him to a deeper understanding of his purpose.

St. Paul’s Letter to the Romans encourages us to present our bodies as a living sacrifice, calling us to the transformation of our hearts and minds. He challenges us to let go of our human ways of thinking and to embrace a life that reflects Christ’s love and sacrifice. We are called to align our lives with God’s will.

In the Gospel, Matthew presents the true nature of discipleship. Discipleship means denying ourselves. Jesus invites us to take up our crosses and follow Him. We are challenged to let go of our human ways of thinking and seeing things and to align ourselves with the will of God. Jesus asks us for a deeper commitment—one that acknowledges our struggles and challenges. Through perseverance, we are led to eternal life.

Let us learn to embrace our sufferings and challenges by submitting our lives to God and allowing Him to inspire us to persevere. Our calling comes from God, so we must align ourselves with His will. This means seeking God each day and learning from Him the meaning and purpose of our lives.

When our hearts and minds are transformed, we will truly live according to God’s will.

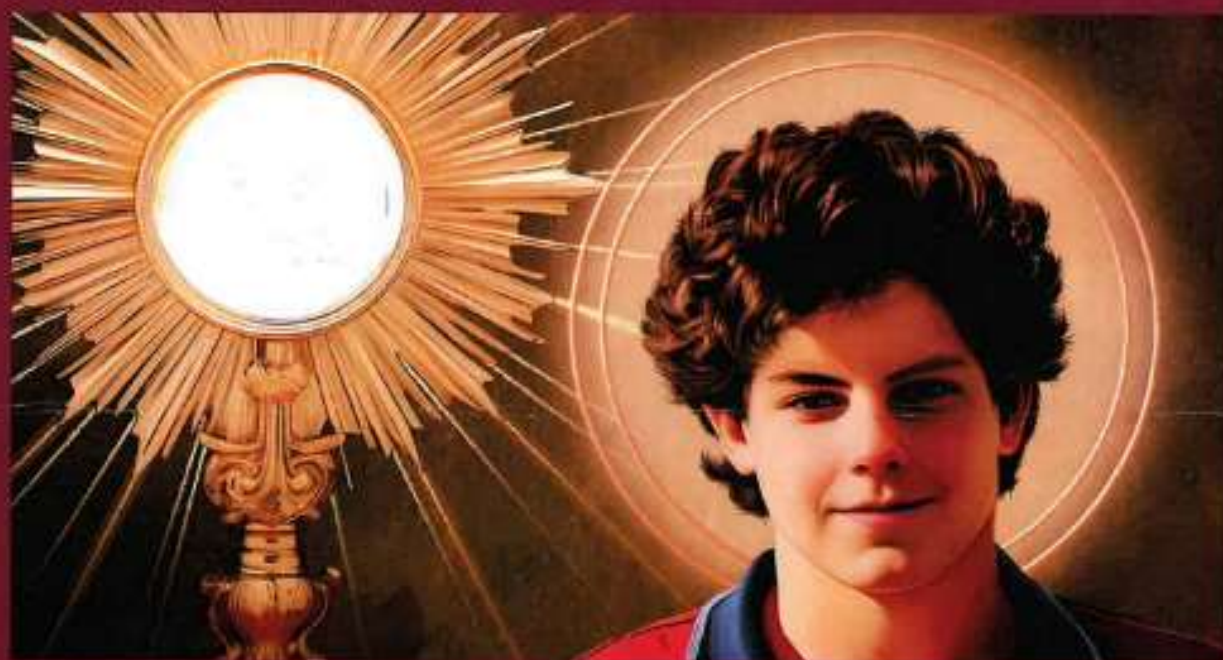

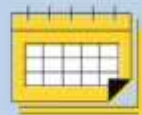
