## From Monsignor Ron ...

In our gospel passage this weekend, Christ offers to us this beautifully striking image of the vineyard, when describing the intimate nature of the relationship between himself and his disciples. He is saying that his followers are to be so closely united with him as to share his ideals, attitudes and concerns. The vine, with its life-giving energy, is a vibrant and dynamic image of the Christian community. Just as a branch is dependent on the vine for food and life, we are dependent on Jesus for divine life and spiritual sustenance. This is one of the main themes of St John's gospel, that of belonging and the profound oneness that exists between each one of us and Christ, who is our life.

We can easily forget that as branches of the same vine, we are also connected to one another and called to form a community of love. It is not sufficient to have a personal relationship with Christ if we fail to reach out in love and understanding to those with whom we rub shoulders in the course of our daily work. We are all expected to look after, care for and have a responsibility towards one another. Our belonging to Christ challenges us to move beyond petty jealousies and realize that we need each other.

We all know that there are areas of our lives where there is dead wood which, instead of producing new and more fruitful growth, is sapping our energy. Jesus teaches emphatically that true discipleship consists in producing the fruit of good living. The gospel is very much our gospel of hope. This is a good time to learn that if we stay connected to the vine, we will bear much fruit, more than we ever imagined.

Today, let us realize the without Jesus we are really nothing and our lives a waste of time. Let us realize the importance of developing a deep friendship with him which comes from prayer, study and doing his will. Finally, if we truly love Jesus we are to love those he loves. The best way we can express our love for others is to bring Jesus to them by continuing his work. Remember, we are not on our own; we are united to Jesus always; as well, the Holy Spirit lives within us and he is our energizer, our guide, our comforter, and of course our challenger. Each day, ask fervently for the power of the Holy Spirit.

### PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

Lord of the harvest, the yield of believers is plentiful, but the workers are few. In your mercy send more labourers among your people to guide them and to pick their plentiful fruit. Grant that I may be a worthy servant in your kingdom, where you live and reign with your Son, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit, for ever and ever. Amen.
