From Monsignor Ron ...

Obviously, after Jesus ascended into heaven his disciples would miss his guidance and instruction. Jesus, being very aware of this, gave to them his Holy Spirit so that his mission would continue. We have received the same Holy Spirit in Baptism and in Confirmation. In fact, the Holy Spirit lives within us from the moment of our Baptism. Holy Spirit is present as our teacher, guide, consoler, energiser and friend. This is an important point to take note of because it is a reminder that we all are the successors of the Apostles.

To be apostles of Jesus, I believe it is important that we become people like Amos. We need to accept that we are chosen and sent by God himself and as a result of this we should never allow ourselves to be distracted from our mission. As well, we need to be like St Paul, who rejoices in the blessings he has received from God in Christ and is eager to share those blessings with the people he encounters. Finally, we need to be like the Apostles who strive to live the Good News as well as possible in every circumstance of life.

Each time we come to celebrate our Mass we are renewed and refreshed. We are given the opportunity to make a new beginning on our own faith journey. But, we need to realise that this is not just for our own private journey. Our response to our encounters with Jesus in the Mass needs to express itself in the way we live our lives and in the ways we show the promise of Jesus concerning love and mercy to others.

At times, if not all the time, we may wonder why God has chosen us to do this. One of the things we do need to realise is that we were not created by accident. We were especially created to live in this world at this time as God's gifts to the world and to become co-workers of Jesus in applying his message to our world today. I would suggest that if we commit ourselves to this mission that we will find like Amos and the apostles did, that we can do a tremendous amount with the power of God's Holy Spirit operating through us. All that is needed is our commitment, our personal relationship to the Holy Spirit, and our daily activation of the gifts of the Holy Spirit which we have received.

God of all nations, we are most grateful for the first Catholic missionaries and explorers who came to Australia As strangers in a strange land they brought with them countless skills, talents and traditions, but their greatest treasure was their faith. SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM FOR RECONCILIATION

Registration forms may be collected from the parish office from July 24.

The registration evening for the sacramental program will take place on Tuesday evening August 7 in the Parish Church. The classes for this program will take place on August 19, 26 and September 2. The reception of the sacrament will be offered on Saturday mornings September 15th and 22nd at 9:30am. This is a parish based program which means it is open to parishioners of St Andrew the Apostle Parish Marayong. To be a parishioner means you either live in the parish boundaries or you have chosen this place as your place of involvement in the Church.

To be eligible, the candidates need to be at least in year two at school and have received the Sacrament of Baptism.

Unfortunately, it has become necessary to point out that the registration evening and the classes are all compulsory if the candidates are to receive the sacrament. While it is understandable that legitimate reasons might prevent people from attending one of these occasions, what has become clear is that a number of families have failed to attend the required classes in our recent sacramental programs. The decision has now been taken that unless there is a legitimate reason, the candidates will not be eligible for the sacraments unless they complete the program. We do hope for your cooperation in this as it is to the obvious advantage of the candidates to receive the sacrament.
