#### "LET US BEGIN AGAIN AS WE PREPARE TO MEET JESUS AT CHRISTMAS"

We celebrate this weekend the beginning of a new liturgical year, with the First Sunday of Advent, Year A. Our readings ask us to reflect on the difference that the coming of Christ into our world makes for us. Because God loved the world so much, he sent Jesus, his Son, to be like us in all things, but sin. Jesus reveals to us how much God loves us and how we are invited to be witnesses of the Good News by words and deeds.

By following God's commandments our lives are transformed and we become a new creation and we are challenged to live in accordance with the truth of the power and love of God for us and all creation. The 'normal' ways of living are not sufficient any longer, the prophet Isaiah even declares that "Nation will not lift sword against nation," and that instruments of war will be transformed into tools to help things grow and flourish.

As we begin our Advent journey, we are invited to see this time of preparation for Christmas as an opportunity to be even more open to the transforming power of the Holy Spirit in our lives. Jesus warns that it is not automatic that people will recognise the difference that the Good News makes for ourselves and our world. Just like the people in Noah's time, people can be oblivious to the reality of God's love for us and how we are invited to respond. As individuals, especially at this time of year, we can be so caught up in wrapping up the year, getting presents, planning events around Christmas and the January period, preparing for Christmas and so much more that we are blind to the opportunities given to us to be loving, kind, compassionate and even more basically, of being of service to those around us.

We could imagine that God could have come among us in many different ways, but Jesus came as a baby and I believe this reality invites us to recognise our responsibility to look after the most vulnerable in our lives and world. Belief in God changes our perspective and so our Advent journey invites to be more open to the transforming power of God in our lives.

#### Advent Wreath

The wreath's symbolism of the advent (coming) of Light into the world is clear. The gradual lighting of the four candles, one on each Sunday of the Advent season, combined with the liturgical colours of the candles (purple is the penitential color used during Advent and Lent; rose is a liturgical colour used only on Gaudete Sunday in Advent

and Laetare Sunday in Lent) help to symbolize not only our expectation and hope in Our Saviour's first coming into the world, but also in his Second Coming as Judge at the end of the world.

# Blessing and Prayer

Priest: Let us pray (pause for silent prayer)
Father, all powerful Lord of Light, bless + our
wreath. May the increasing light of these candles
brighten our minds and hearts to be steadfast in
faith, joyful in hope and untiring in love, so that we
are ready again to receive in true peace Jesus, the
Light of the World, who lives and reigns with you,
for ever and ever. Amen.

[Sprinkling follows. The first candle is lit, and the prayer for the first week is said.]

Priest: Let us pray. Stir up your might, we beg you, O Lord, and come, so that we may escape through your protection and be saved by your help from the dangers that threaten us because of our sins. We ask this of you who lives and reigns for ever and ever. All: Amen.
